PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project consists of the design, construction, and modification of LPSs at BON and JDA.

Specific tasks (pending funding availability and prioritization) include the following:

1. Design, build, and or modify LPSs that address known problem areas:
 - a. BON Washington Shore Fish Ladder – Install 2 new ramps in the channel between the UMT junction and count station, as a means of reducing the use of the serpentine weir section. Completed IWW 16/17.
 - b. BON Bradford Island Fish Ladder – Upgrade to LPS exit chute (out for solicitation June 2017; construction IWW 17/18)
 - c. BON Cascades Island Fish Ladder – Only minor modifications to the LPS as outlined under bullet 2.
 - d. JDA North Fish Ladder – Extend entrance LPS to the 2nd 180 degree turning pool (Design late FY17; Construction IWW 18/19).
2. Complete minor modifications to existing LPSs to improve O&M functionality:
 - a. Inspect structures and modify as necessary to minimize risk of structural failures.
 - b. Modify or replace pumps and pump intakes, as necessary, to meet juvenile salmon fry criteria, accommodate maintenance needs, and provide sufficient water supply for systems.
 - c. Improve counting systems for existing LPSs.
 - d. Improve electrical and plumbing systems (as needed) for existing LPSs.
 - e. Install full duplex systems at the LPS exits.

PROGRESS AND KEY ISSUES (List)

BON WA Shore

- University of Idaho is currently evaluating new entrance ramps.
- USACE Fish Field Unit currently evaluating lamprey orifices and refuge boxes.

BON Bradford Island and Cascades Island

- Package is being prepared for solicitation.
