Please note the following additional conditions as they may apply to this permit.

- Purchaser copy of valid permit must accompany fish during shipment and be retained at destination.
- Fish health inspection reports must be provided with any requests to import fish or eggs into Oregon.
- Shipper/buyer must obtain any other permits or inspections required for transport or import to final destination.
- Notes: Owner will prevent fish from escaping. These lamprey will be used to test the effects of barotrauma on the fish through stimulated turbine passage route. Research funded by the USECOE. These lamprey are for laboratory use only. None will be used in field studies or otherwise released. A separate permit will be acquired from WDFW. Upto 250 fish.
