Dear Ms. Baker:

This is in response to your March 4, 2015 letter requesting approval to access Bonneville's Adult Fish Facility (AFF) for the purpose of PIT-tagging Pacific lamprey (*Entosphenus tridentata*) from May through September. It is understood that this effort is part of an attempt to determine lamprey escapement estimates to the Hood River and to Fifteenmile Creek, which in past years were determined using fish the University of Idaho had tagged. Your proposal states that you will be duplicating the methods developed by the University of Idaho, including targeting 2% of the lamprey run as discussed, and that the tagged lamprey will be released at points upstream from Bonneville Dam.

Please note, the Columbia River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission (CRITFC) has agreed to undertake the responsibility for collecting and holding lamprey for your research.

With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary ESA and state, or tribal permits. No work may begin until permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file with the Ms. Ida Royer and Ms. Tammy Mackey. Prior to beginning work, please arrange a meeting with Ms. Ida Royer, 541-374-2541. Please remain in contact with Ms. Royer throughout your time at the dam. There are many researchers and contractors working at the dam, please work to ensure good communication and cooperation between agencies and organizations.
