Dear Mr. Miller:

This is in response to your April 1, 2019 letter requesting approval for access to The Dalles Dam for Four Peaks Environmental Science & Data Solutions fish counting plan. All visual counters will start conducting live counts on May 6, 2019, continuing through October 31, 2019. Fish counts will occur from 0500-2100 hrs (PDT). Counts will occur 7 days per week. There will be no off-season video in 2019 but will record and review night video from June 15, 2019 through September 30, 2019.

With respect to the work outlined above, your request is generally approved, provided you are able to obtain all necessary documentation. You will need to provide a detailed work statement, project impact statement, job hazard analysis, ESA and state permits, any Material Safety Data Sheets that are applicable and a personnel list noting current First Aid/CPR training. No work may begin until valid and current permits, or an explanation as to why permits are not required, are on file. Please send electronic copies of these documents to Jeff Randall [Jeffrey.W.Randall@usace.army.mil](mailto:Jeffrey.W.Randall@usace.army.mil) and Erin Kovalchuk [Erin.H.Kovalchuk@usace.army.mil](mailto:Erin.H.Kovalchuk@usace.army.mil). You will be required to comply with all reporting requirements found in the current FPP section TDA 3.3.3. Prior to beginning work, please arrange a meeting with Jeff Randall, 541-298-7405.

There are many researchers and contractors working in the area. Please remain in contact with Jeff Randall throughout your time at the dam in order to ensure good communication and cooperation between other agencies and organizations.
