Dear Mr. Twiner,

The intent of this letter is to request access to The Dalles Dam to carry out opportunistic sampling of White Sturgeon encountered during routine and ad hoc maintenance outages. I will be the primary contact and project lead for this effort though it may include staff from Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife, the Columbia River Inter-tribal Fish Commission and the Northwest Power and Conservation Council.

I am requesting access to The Dalles Dam deck for myself, Laura Heironimus, Colin Chapman, Kevin Rybacki, Mike Lovejoy, Brad Cady, Shaffryn Schade, Laurie Lloyd and Lynn Palensky from January 1 – December 31, 2019. Our samplers will coordinate closely with Jeff Randall (Research Coordinator – USACE) in order to collect basic morphometric data and to PIT-tag any sturgeon found during de-watering.

I will provide all necessary pre-project documentation required of researchers working at The Dalles Dam as specified by yourself or Jeff Randall. Should staffing change during the course of the year, I will provide you with all necessary contact information so that security clearance and access badges can be issued.
