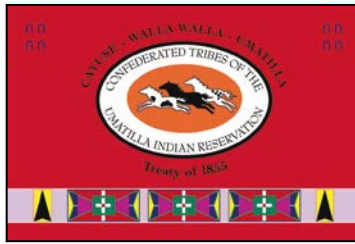

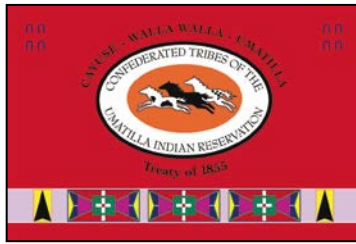

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND AUTHORIZATION OF THIS PERMIT:

1. This permit cannot be used in lieu of any permit required by federal law or regulation. Permission to sample in areas where federally protected fish may occur is contingent upon the permittee obtaining necessary authorization from the federal agency and acting in accordance with the conditions established by the federal government.
2. This permit must be carried by authorized collector(s) on site while sampling. Persons not named above may assist in collecting only while accompanied by authorized collector(s) listed above.
3. Access to private property is contingent on the permission of the landowner.
4. Local state Fish and Wildlife co-managers shall be notified (copy of this permit) one week prior to sampling activities.
5. No protected species may be taken unless specifically listed below and any other necessary federal authorizations have been granted.

SPECIFIC PURPOSE, CONDITIONS AND AUTHORIZATION OF THIS PERMIT:

1. Target species to be collected: Adult Pacific Lamprey
Action: Collect up to 1952 adults for continuation of Umatilla and Grande Ronde basin lamprey re-introductions
2. Collection location(s): Bonneville (n=976), The Dalles (n=671) and John Day (n=467) dams.
3. Project purpose: To continue re-establishment of Pacific Lamprey to self-sustaining, harvestable levels in the Umatilla and Grande Ronde basins through approved adult translocation.
4. Collection method: At Bonneville Dam, The Dalles and John Day dams, CTUIR would collect lamprey from traps operated by CRITFC staff. Collected lampreys will be transported in an insulated 300 gallon slip tank to the South Fork Walla Walla Adult Holding Facility and/or Minthorn Springs on the Umatilla River to overwinter and will be released in the spring 2021.
5. Release locations in Umatilla River: Near Bear Creek confluence in the Umatilla River, near Camp Creek confluence in Meacham Creek, and near Little Iskúultpe Creek confluence in Iskúultpe Creek.
Release location in Grande Ronde River: near Starkey Weir and Vey Meadows in the Upper Grande Ronde, in Wenaha River, Catherine, Lookingglass, Little Lookingglass, McCoy, Meadow, Indian, Willow, E. Sheep, Limber Jim and Five Points creeks and others TBD.
6. Take of incidentally caught ESA fish is to be avoided. Handling of any incidentally caught ESA listed fish shall be minimized to reduce stress. CTUIR staff would have no contact with ESA listed fish for this activity.
7. Indirect mortality may not exceed 5% of the total sample taken for any species at any site.
8. A take report for all species captured or handled will be filed with appropriate coordinating agencies upon completion of this work within the calendar year in which it takes place. Final results will also be available through annual progress reports.
