## Section 1. Comments

A complete 24 hour sample was collected this week. Debris was very heavy, the river is very dirty, visibility is about 6". Subyearling Chinook fry numbers continue to decline and on average are larger. Considering the amount of debris in the river, fish condition was good, see Section 5 below for details. There were no fish found on the ground this week so the net extensions seem to have worked. There was jump in the number of Pacific lamprey sampled this week, likely in response to the high flows.
